

WILDERNESS TENTING RIDES

These trips explore some of Goose Arm's spectacular backcountry. Join us on a 1, 2, 3 or 4 day wilderness tenting ride. Tenting camps at Island Pond, Bear Lake and Old Man's Pond are of similar set up with wash stand and hot water, a fire pit for evening socializing, tent accommodations and delicious home cooked meals. The rides are casual with breaks and leisurely lunches.



BACKCOUNTRY LODGE RIDES

For folks who are looking to take a little bit of home into the backcountry, Lomond River Lodge provides all the comforts of home. Like wilderness tenting rides, days are spent horseback riding and exploring. Unlike the tenting rides, evenings are spent in a cozy lodge. We call that roughing it the civilized way. Your choice of 1 or 2 day lodge rides.

For people who want something different, we can custom design a trip to suit your requirements.

DEPARTURE TIMES & LOCATIONS

Riders meet at Cache Rapids Stable in Reidville where they will be transported by vehicle to the starting point for their ride. **ONE DAY RIDES** depart at 1 pm. and return 12 noon the following day. **TWO, THREE AND FOUR DAY RIDES** depart at 9:30 am. and return by 5 pm.

Minimum of 2 people required per trip.

Maximum of 10 people per trip.

Discounted prices available for 4 people or more.

All prices are subject to 15% HST.

Lomond River Lodge is located on the banks of Lomond River on the outskirts of Gros Morne National Park. There are 6 two bedroom cabins with a full bathroom, kitchen, dining area and living room complete with propane fireplace. The lodge also has 3 motel units, takeout, laundromat, trailer park and a lounge.



WILDERNESS TENTING PACKAGES

- 1. Lomond River Overnighter (1 day/1 night)**
Ride to Lomond, Gros Morne National Park. Arrive at our stable in Reidville at 12 noon to prepare for the ride. Ride departs at 1:30 pm. from Wiltendale and returns at 1:00 pm. the following day. \$545 per adult. Children 12 and under \$495.
- 2. Island Pond Overnighter (1 day/1 night)**
Backcountry tenting trip to Island Pond in Goose Arm. Ride departs at 1 pm and returns at 12 noon the following day. \$545. per adult. Children 12 and under \$495.
- 3. Old Mans Pond (2 day/1 night)**
Ride to Old Man's Pond, on the north side of Deer Lake. \$645. per adult. Children 12 and under \$595.
- 4. Lomond River/Tablelands (2day/1 night)**
Ride to Lomond River and the Tablelands. Arrive at our stable in Reidville at 9:30 am. to prepare for the ride. Ride departs at 10:30 am. from Wiltendale. On day two, we will trailer the horses to Shoal Brook in Gros Morne where you will ride to the Tablelands and return to the stable in Reidville at 5 pm. \$645. per adult. Children 12 and under \$595.

- 5. Island Pond via Grindstone (2 day/1 night)**
Deer Lake to Island Pond returning via Grindstone Pond route. \$645. per adult. Children 12 and under \$595.
- 6. Bear Lake Ride (2 days/1 night)**
Deer Lake to Bear Lake returning via Old Goose Arm Road. \$695. per adult. Children 12 and under \$645.
- 7. Forest to Sea (4 days/3 nights)**
Riding through forest and lake country from Deer Lake to Goose Arm and back via Old Man's Pond. Long days - this ride is for people who are comfortable in the saddle. \$1345. per adult. Children 12 and under \$1295.



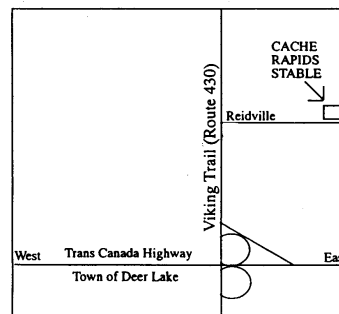
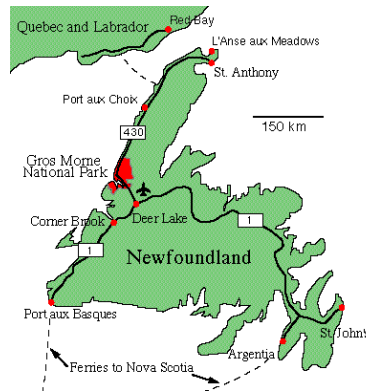
BACKCOUNTRY LODGE RIDES

- 8. Lomond River Lodge (1 day/1 night)**
Ride to Lomond River, Gros Morne National Park. Deluxe cabin accommodations at Lomond River Lodge. Arrive at our stable in Reidville at 12 noon to prepare for the ride. Ride departs at 1:30 pm from Wiltendale and returns at 1:00 pm. the following day. \$595. per adult. Children 12 and under \$545.
- 9. Lomond River Lodge/Tablelands (2 day/1 night)**
Our most popular ride. Ride to Lomond River and the Tablelands Gros Morne National Park. Arrive at our stable in Reidville at 9:30 am. to prepare for the ride. Ride departs at 10:30 am from Wiltendale. On day two, we will trailer the horses to Shoal Brook in Gros Morne where you will ride to the Tablelands and return to

the stable by 5 pm . \$695 per adult. Children 12 and under \$645.



HOW TO GET HERE

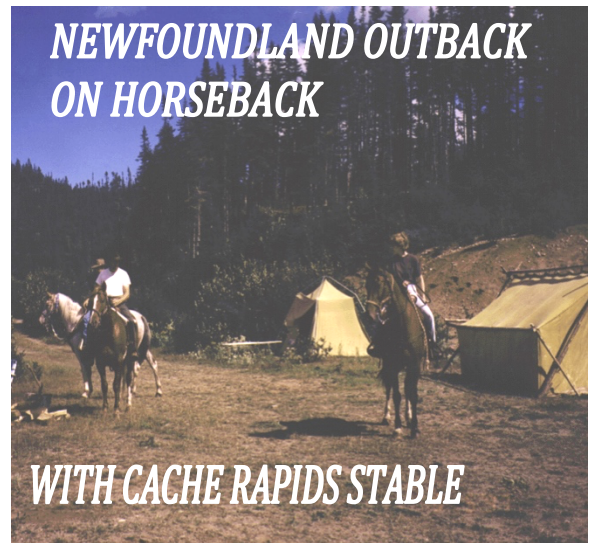


- At Deer Lake, Exit Route 1 (Trans Canada Highway) to Route 430 (Viking Trail).

BOOKING INFORMATION

Departure Times & Locations – Riders meet at Cache Rapids Stable, 255 Reidville Road in Reidville. From there, the duffel will be loaded and passengers will be transported by vehicle to the starting point for their ride.

ONE-DAY RIDES depart at 1:30 pm. and return at 12 noon the following day. **Check-in time is 12 noon.**

TWO, THREE AND FOUR-DAY RIDES depart at 10 am. and return at 5 pm. **Check-in time is 9:30 am.**

Vehicle – You can leave your vehicle at our stable in Reidville.

Trips Include – guide, horse, all meals, tent or lodge accommodations and all equipment except sleeping bags/pillows and personal items.

Making a Reservation – Simply fill out the application form with the requested information and mail, fax or email information.

Confirmation of Reservation – We request a deposit of \$200.00 to confirm your ride. Balance is due day of ride, prior to departure.

Payments – Payments may be made by cash, e-transfer or credit/debit cards.

Cancellations – Notice of cancellation must be received 7 days prior to departure for a full refund. No refunds will be given on any trip in progress.

Indemnities – Each rider will be required to sign a waiver releasing Cache Rapids Stable from all risks.

Medical Information – In the event of an accident or injury, we require pertinent medical information. i.e. Allergies, etc.

Taxes – All prices are subject to 15% HST.

Gratuities – Gratuities are customary and very much appreciated.

Custom Trips - For people who want something different, we can custom design a trip to suit your requirements.

The Trail Guide – is in charge at all times. It is important that guests follow the guide's instructions at all times. The guide will ride the lead horse on all rides and will accompany riders on all side trips.

What to bring – Mother Nature can be unpredictable, so guests need to come prepared for every type of weather. Clothing that is easily layered works best. You can always remove what you don't need, but you still have it just in case. Also, bring your most comfortable gear --this is not the time to break-in new boots or a new hat.

Your coats, rain gear, hat and gloves are packed separately from your duffel and are either worn or tied with saddle strings to the back of your saddle. We supply saddlebags. Please fill them only with essential items that you would need during the day, such as lip balm, you camera, sunscreen, etc. Daypacks, backpacks or other bags are not allowed – they are hard on your back and hard on the horse's back, and do not tie properly to the saddle.

WHAT TO BRING

The following list details suggested items to bring with you.

- **A warm sleeping bag** – for tenting trips only. Lomond River Lodge provides all linens and bedding.
- **A warm coat** – Also bring a heavy sweater or fleece jacket.
- **Rain Gear** – A rain coat and rain pants, and if possible, coverings for your boots and hat. Rain ponchos are not permitted as they flap in the wind and spook the horses.
- **Shirts** – 2 sweatshirts, 1 long-sleeved shirt and 2 t-shirts.
- **Jeans** – we suggest 1 pair for riding and 1 for wearing around the camp at night.
- **Riding boots** – A boot with a heel that can easily slip in and out of stirrups, or a narrow style of hiking boot or solid sneaker. Plastic bags inside your boots will keep your feet dry on rainy days. An extra pair of dry socks.
- **Sneakers** – or an extra pair of shoes for wearing around camp, and extra pair of dry socks is recommended.
- **Toiletries** – towels, face cloth, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, disposable razors, etc. We supply toilet paper and hand soap at all camps.
- **Flashlight**
- **Riding Helmets** – must be worn by riders 18 years of age and under. All riders are encouraged to wear helmets. A cowboy hat or canvas type baseball cap are also fine. Please ensure that your hat fits snug or ties on and will not blow off in the wind. **Riding Helmets are provided.**
- **Gloves** – Leather lined or suede gloves provide protection from the elements and a sure grip on the reins (bring two pair just in case one gets wet).
- **Sunscreen**, Sunglasses and mosquito repellent.
- **Camera.**

On my behalf, and on behalf of any minor children participating in these activities, for whom I am legally responsible, I agree to the following:

ASSUMPTION OF RISKS

I am aware and understand that activities involving these horses involve many risks, dangers and hazards, including, but not limited to the following:

1. Horses, which are powerful and potentially dangerous animals, may change their behavior at any time and may, without warning, jump, run wildly, buck, kick, bite or step on people or things:
2. Horses may collide with other horses or objects or trip, stumble or fall even if being led, ridden or attended to:
3. Negligence (which means, in general terms, a failure to exercise ordinary or proper care) of other riders or my child's own failure to ride safely, within my child's ability or within designated areas and trails:
4. Equipment may fail:
5. Weather conditions can change and can sometimes be dangerous:
6. The nature of the terrain can change and has certain risks associated with it including, but not limited to, exposed natural objects, trees, streams and creeks:
7. The activities can sometimes be in remote areas and injuries or illness may occur and it may be a considerable distance to doctors, hospitals, or any other type of assistance; and
8. Negligence on the part of A PROPERTY OWNER AND /OR THE PROVIDER OR THEIR STAFF.

I am also aware that the risks, dangers and hazards referred to above exist throughout the trail, stable, practice and other areas and many are unmarked. I understand and acknowledge that no amount of caution, experience or instruction can eliminate all of the risks involved and I freely accept and fully assume all such risks, dangers and hazards and the possibility of personal injury, death, property damage and damages or loss resulting therefrom.

RELEASE OF LIABILITY, WAIVER OF CLAIMS AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration of the Provider providing me or my child with their horses or sleigh riding and other services and permitting me or my child's use of their equipment, and other facilities and the Property Owners providing me or my child with the use of their property (hereinafter collectively referred to as "the Services"), I hereby agree as follows:

1. TO WAIVE ANY AND ALL CLAIMS that I or my child have or may in the future have against a Property Owner or the Provider, and their directors, officers, employees, agents, representatives, and volunteers (all of whom are hereinafter collectively referred to as "THE RELEASEES") and TO RELEASE THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any loss, damage, injury or expense that I or my or my child may suffer, or that my or my child's next of kin may suffer as a result of my child's use of the services or due to any cause whatsoever, INCLUDING NEGLIGENCE, BREACH OF CONTRACT, OR BREACH OF ANY STATUTORY OR OTHER DUTY OF CARE INCLUDING ANY DUTY OF CARE OWNED UNDER THE "OCCUPIERS LIABILITY ACT" ON THE PART OF THE RELEASEES;
2. TO HOLD HARMLESS AND INDEMNIFY THE RELEASEES from any and all liability for any damage to the property of or personal injury to any third party resulting from my or my child's use of the services;
3. This agreement shall be effective and binding upon my or my child's heirs, next of kin, executors, administrators, assigns and representatives in the event of my or my child's death or incapacity;
4. This agreement shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the Province of Newfoundland & Labrador; and
5. Any litigation involving the parties in this Agreement shall be brought within the Province of Newfoundland & Labrador.

In entering into this Agreement, I am not relying on any oral or written representations or statements made by the Releasees other than what is set forth in this Agreement.

I fully understand the risks involved while riding horses and that if an accident should occur involving an injury, I will not hold the Ranch or Stable responsible.
